Project Description

The Downtown Austin Alliance is seeking a summer intern with knowledge in GIS, planning and urban design to assist with and prepare a series of maps and illustrations regarding downtown Austin, including the creation and management of supporting databases. The project involves the following:

- Gathering GIS data and information from various sources (including, but not limited to the City of Austin) in order to establish an update in-house GIS data library for the Downtown Austin Alliance.
- Organization and management of GIS data in an efficient and effective system for continued and future use by Downtown Austin Alliance staff.
- Use gathered mapping data to create and design a series of maps and graphics in ArcGIS that help illustrate a number of planning and urban conditions of downtown and its districts and neighborhoods.
- It may be necessary to complete spatial analysis of gathered data to convey some concepts.
- Maps shall be designed to a quality and style that builds on the Downtown Austin Alliance brand and provides a visually compelling and clear message(s).
- Data and maps shall be structured in a way that provides sufficient flexibility for use on future projects.
- Maps and data shall be prepared and organized in a way that syncs with ArcGIS Online, Adobe Creative Suite and other possible mapping and visualizing software.
- In addition to ArcGIS, use and knowledge of other visualization software, such as Adobe Creative Suite, AutoCAD and SketchUp, may be necessary to prepare final graphics.
- Staff will work with the intern to help develop the methodology and outcomes allowing them to be owners of the project utilizing their GIS and critical thinking skills.

Desired Qualifications:

- Must be a Senior or Graduate Student with extensive knowledge and background in ArcGIS.
- Excellent organizational skills and attention to detail
- Strong research, writing, communication and editing abilities
- Proficient in Microsoft Excel
- Proficient with GIS
- Experience in creating/building a project database
- Knowledge of issues and practices pertaining to urban planning, design, and sustainability (preferred)
- Additional skills such as Adobe Creative Suite, AutoCAD and Sketch Up, etc. a plus.
